Perhaps the most significant change for you is the plan to remove a lot of BTEC qualifications over the next couple of years, replacing them with new qualifications. This presents very exciting opportunities for all of you. We believe that, through introducing a range of exciting new courses in our academic and technical pathways, we can provide an even better offer to support you in meeting your desired goals, whether that be into university, apprenticeships or the world of work.

From September 2024, all Sixth Form students at the Priory Academy LSST, the Priory Witham Academy, the Priory Lincoln Academy and the Priory Pembroke Academy will be treated as part of the same wider Sixth Form.
